Content Policy:

- We happily accept paid guest posts on our UK Education Blog (education.clickdo.co.uk)
- Only original concepts, well-researched arguments, and high-quality content will be published. We will not publish content that's been published elsewhere.
- Every guest article should consist of well-written content with proper attribution of data, quotations, and high-quality outside content referenced in each article.
- Useful and relevant images or graphics can be added to enhance the content (royalty free images from platforms like Pexels, Pixabay, Unsplash are preferred) and you are responsible for referencing and checking the images you provide.
- Plagiarized and grammatically incorrect contents will be disapproved
- Each blog post should contain a minimum of 600 words and relevant images in it
- After submitting your guest post, it will be manually reviewed by our editorial team
- You should place adequate and correct reference links in the drafts you send to us. Links are final once approved and cannot be changed or updated later



for any reasons. The contextual reference links should add value to the reader and should not be used for SEO purposes.

How guest articles are published:

Please use the contact form or email address on our blog to provide:

- Title and brief paragraph about the main outline.
- Word count
- Your graphic/image suggestions

If approved, send the following:

- Your completed post as a Google Doc or Word Doc.
- Image files (with attribution) in a separate folder.
- Short author bio including a maximum of one anchor text link to your own website.

Post-publication reserved rights and duties:

- You cannot republish your guest post to your own blog or any other platform after we have published it. However, you are free to share it like crazy with your social media audience.
- Once your guest post is published, we reserve the right to edit and adapt it as we see fit. We might update it in the future for accuracy and comprehensiveness.
- We reserve the right to include relevant links within our UK Education Blog to articles.

Payment Policy:

- You can publish paid guest blogs on our UK Education Blog (education.clickdo.co.uk).
- You are required to pay the agreed amount.
- After your guest article has been published, you should make the payment within two working days from the publication date.
- Preferred Payment Gateway – PayPal or to our ClickDo UK bank account (details will be provided in our invoice)



- If we haven't received your payment within the two working days, we will remove the contextual reference links from your blog posts until payment is received. The published blog post will still be live without your external links.
- NO REFUNDS will be given for any reasons.
